



Fox Valley Orchestra Young People's Concerts is "Full STEAM Ahead" for Tuesday, May 10, 2016 at the Paramount Theatre in Aurora.

The fun begins with a show at **11:00 a.m.** which is restricted to class field trips. A late afternoon show will take place at **4:30pm** which will be ticketed and open to the public. The program will be approximately 50 minutes in length.

This Fox Valley Orchestra will be performing "Carnival of the Animals" by Camille Saint-Saens, "Fanfare for the Common Man" by Aaron Copland, and "Star Wars" music by John Williams. The "Full STEAM (*science, technology, engineering, art, and math*) Ahead" experience is geared towards 1st through 5th grade students, though all students are welcome. Educational materials will be sent to you for supplemental classroom activities and discussion related to the performance upon registration.

SciTech Hands On Museum, located two blocks from the Paramount, will provide program options to add to your fieldtrip either before or after your "Full STEAM Ahead" experience. Groups may book a 60 – 90 minutes long field trip beginning before or after the performance at the Paramount. SciTech will contact those groups who wish to take advantage of this special pricing!

Cost to attend SciTech: **\$5 per student / adult (Concert Day Only Price)**
